Please note, this is very important:

The reason for this is because I'm going to try to send out as few pieces of paper as possible. With the new Postal rate increase it is getting even more expensive for the club to be mailing things out. Ideally, I'm shooting for 100 percent email; however, I do realize that some of you may not have web access. This will be the last newsletter that I mail out paper to everyone that requested a paper version. Starting with the next issue if the club has an email address for you, you will receive your newsletter by email. Electronic newsletters are becoming the way that most clubs (4WD or otherwise) are communicating with their members because of cost and time.

To keep things simple and small the emailed version will contain only the text of the newsletter. This doesn't mean that the pretty version with pictures and graphics is going away. The email you receive will contain a link to download the pretty printable version (an Adobe Reader PDF file) of the newsletter. Not automatically sending out a large PDF file means that unless your mailbox is completely full, you should still receive the newsletter. Another advantage is that you'll be able to download the PDF file when it's convenient for you and not be forced to a long mysterious connection when getting your new email messages.
